CPR TRAINING - Arrangements have been made through St. Marks Church and the Red Cross to have CPR training for VWS members! The class will be four 3-hour sessions (2 nights per week, 2 consecutive weeks) and will result in Red Cross certification for those successfully completing it. The dates are not firm as of yet, but will be mid to late July or early to mid August, depending on the preference of the class and availability of materials.
